MERLOT 2017

Tasting Note

This moreish Merlot is smooth and medium bodied with lovely fresh fruit flavours of cherry and plum, along with fragrantly herbal notes. It is juicy and approachable, finishing with soft tannins.

Winemaking

Fruit was harvested when flavour ripe and fermented on skins for 5 days with gentle pump-overs to create a soft and approachable wine. Matured for 15 months with minimal oak contact and bottled whilst still youthful to maintain freshness and vibrancy of fruit.

Vintage

After above average rainfall during winter, Autumn was fortunately dry and stable, although still relatively cool. This caused a later-than-usual harvest, with wines more medium in body, showing bright fruit flavours and plenty of elegance and finesse.
